Grade 12 Course Timeline



'Treaties & the Treaty Relationship' course is developed by TRCM

2017-2018

Founded in a resolution passed by the Assembly of Manitoba Chiefs and repeated requests from the province's education community, the TRCM pens a 1-credit grade 12 capstone course framed on Treaties.

Course is field tested and vetted

2018-2019

Two Treaty 5-based schools pilot the course. The course is edited based on their input. Students and teachers meet in May 2019 for a celebratory 'Treaty Learning Day'.

2020+

SIC is made available to schools

'Treaty Education for All' provincial mandate

2023

The goal is to ensure that all school staff and students receive Treaty Education. The mandate includes a department-developed grade 12 course building on the existing school-initiated course (SIC).

Interested schools are given the full course, tips for registering an SIC, a supplementary document to help localize, and ongoing professional development and support. By June 2025, self-reporting indicates over 250 students have attained course credit.

2023-2024

TRCM shares course with Manitoba Education

Manitoba Education course launch

2025

The TRCM and Manitoba Education rework the course to conform to provincial curricular structures. The learning outcomes from the original course are embedded. The SIC course is available while this rework occurs.
